

2023 Term 2 Curriculum in Prep

at Highland Reserve State School



English

Students will continue to develop their oral language by listening to and engaging with a range of literary and non-literary texts with a focus on exploring how language is used to entertain through retelling events. Students will sequence events from a range of texts, including stories from Aboriginal peoples and Torres Strait Islander peoples and select a favourite story to retell to a small group of classmates. They prepare for their spoken retell by drawing events and writing familiar words. Students will identify rhyme and rhyming patterns in stories, poems and songs.

Maths

Students will continue to count to and from 10 and will connect number names with matching numerals, objects and pictures. They will answer simple questions to collect information and make simple inferences.

Science

Students will continue to develop their understanding of Science by observing and asking questions about topics including the properties of materials. They will participate in guided investigations and engage in discussions about their observations.

Design Technologies

Students will explore the purpose of familiar products, materials and how they meet the needs of users. They will create and communicate ideas using simple drawings. Students will follow sequenced steps and evaluate their designs.
