2023 Term 3 Curriculum in Year 1

English

Students listen to, read, view and interpret picture books and stories that are familiar and/or from different cultures. They write a retelling of their favourite story using a story map.

Maths

Students will give and follow directions to familiar locations using positional and directional language. They will learn to tell the time to the half hour and will describe time durations using months, weeks, days and hours. Students will solve simple subtraction problems using a range of strategies. They will continue to explore numbers up to 100.

Science

Students will investigate the observable features of a variety of landscapes and skies. Students will pose and respond to questions, make predictions and share ideas with others through guided investigations about changes in the sky and landscapes and how they affect everyday life.
