Literacy

- **Reading:**
 - Read a story together and ask questions about the book that you have read.
 - Questions may include: What happened in the book? Who were the characters? Did anything that happened in the story remind you of something that has happened to you?

****Please refer to the oral language poster attached for more question suggestions****
- Practice Concepts of Print with your child: Ask questions like: "Which way do we hold the book? Where do we begin reading? Which way do we go when we read? Point to a letter, point to a word. Where is a capital letter? Where is a full stop?"
- **Writing:**
 - Draw a picture of your favourite part of the book.
 - Daily journal writing.
 - Practice writing their name using a capital to begin with and then lower case letters (e.g. Tim) and words found around the home or in books.
- **Spelling:**
 - Revise the letters and sounds for S/A/T/P/I/N.
 - Practice writing words using these letters (e.g. at, sat, pat, in, pin, tin, nip, tip).
