- Complete set tasks on Mathletics

- Number practice:
 - single digit addition facts (e.g. 8 +1=9)
 - Rainbow facts – numbers that add to 10 (1+9, 2+8, 3+7, 4+6, 5+5)
 - Encourage use of concrete materials around the house or drawing pictures to help solve
- Practice skip counting in 1s, 2s, 5s and 10s counting upwards to and backwards from 100.
