

# 2026 5/6M TERM 2 OVERVIEW

APRIL 20 - June 26

## In 5/6M this term, we will be learning about:

### » ENGLISH

This term, students will learn how the text structures, language features and visual features of informative texts support purpose and meaning, and to use these features to create their own informative texts.

### » MATHS

This term, students will develop their number skills by solving problems using the four operations. They will explore factors and multiples, investigate different types of numbers, and apply their learning to real-world situations involving money and time.

### » SCIENCE (Earth and Space Sciences)

This term, students will explore Earth's place in the solar system and how Earth's movements and gravity create observable patterns such as day and night, seasons, and eclipses.

### » HASS (Business and Economics)

This term, students will explore how choices about using resources affect individuals, communities and the environment, and how people make informed economic decisions.

### » THE ARTS (YR 6: MEDIA, YR5: VISUAL)

This term, Year 6 students will explore documentary techniques and use them to create a short documentary about someone in the school or local community. Year 5 students will explore the elements of art to create and analyse artworks that communicate meaning.
