

2026 YEAR 2 TERM 3 OVERVIEW

July 13 - September 18

In Year 2 this term, we will be learning about:

» ENGLISH

Students are creating written and multimedia persuasive texts based on tourist destinations throughout Australia. They are researching iconic cities and places across the country and learning how to use persuasive language, strong arguments and supporting details to convince an audience to visit their chosen destination.

» MATHS

Students are developing their understanding of multiplication by creating and interpreting arrays and using repeated addition. They are also learning about division by sharing objects into equal groups. In measurement, students will compare and measure length, weight and capacity using appropriate units. They will also explore fractions by identifying and representing halves, quarters and eighths.

» Science

Students are investigating sound and exploring where sounds come from and how they are made. They are learning that sounds are created through vibrations and examining how these vibrations travel to our ears. Throughout the unit, students will design and create their own musical instrument and investigate how different materials and designs can change the sounds produced.

@ HOME

We encourage families to read with their child every day. This can look like: reading a book before bed, and engaging with your child about the book they read and discussing new vocabulary. Conversational Reading, where the adult reads to the child, further extends vocabulary and models fluency when reading is also beneficial at this age. Reading with your child also fosters a curious mindset.
