

2026 YEAR 5 TERM 3 OVERVIEW

13th July - 18th September

In Year 5 this term, we will be learning about:

» ENGLISH

This term students will create spoken and written persuasive responses to issues or dilemmas in texts and real-world topics. Students will practise using features of voice such as tone, volume, pitch and pace. Our English unit will be integrated with our HASS learning, where students will prepare and present a persuasive speech about an individual who was significant in the development of an Australian colony.

» MATHS

Students will be investigating two-dimensional nets of 3D shapes, measuring length, mass and capacity, and solve problems involving perimeter and area. They will estimate, construct and measure angles and investigate fractions, percentages and decimals. Students will use their knowledge to solve financial and other practical problems.

» SCIENCE

This term students will investigate the properties of light and the formation of shadows. They will plan investigations, pose questions, make predictions, represent data and communicate findings.

» HASS

Students will explore the causes of the establishment of British colonies in Australia after 1800. They will investigate significant people who contributed to Australian Colonisation.

NEW ROUTINES THIS TERM

Each fortnight classes will be visiting the HUB to borrow books for home reading.
