

2026 YEAR 6 TERM 3 OVERVIEW

July 13 - September 18

In Year 6 this term, we will be learning about:

» ENGLISH

Students will create a presentation for a travel expo, using persuasive language, topic-specific vocabulary and presentation skills to promote a travel destination and persuade travellers to visit.

» MATHS

Students will develop their understanding of fractions, decimals, measurement, area and angles, and apply these concepts to solve real-world problems. They will explain and justify their mathematical thinking using a range of strategies and representations.

» SCIENCE (Chemical Sciences)

Students will investigate reversible and irreversible changes to materials and explore how these changes affect everyday life. They will develop their scientific inquiry skills by planning fair tests, collecting and analysing data, and using evidence to draw conclusions.

» HASS (Geography)

Students will investigate the geographical diversity of the Asia region and Australia's connections with other countries. They will use maps and data to explore how places, people and cultures differ across the world and examine how Australia is connected to the global community.

NEW ROUTINE THIS TERM

Each fortnight classes will be visiting the HUB to borrow books for home reading. Students will require a protective bag for transporting the books. HRSS library bags are available through Flexischools

This term, you can support
your child's learning by:

- Encouraging regular reading at home.
- Practising multiplication facts and number fluency (a great app to download is Math Facts - Flash Cards)
- Discussing current events and Australian connection to other countries
- Asking your child to explain what they have been learning each week.
