

# 2026 YEAR 6 TERM 2 OVERVIEW

April 20th - June 26

## In Year 6 this term, we will be learning about:

### » ENGLISH - INFORMATIVE TEXTS

Students will read and comprehend a written biography and view a biographical documentary. They will respond to questions about similarities and differences in the use of language features, visual features and text structure.

### » MATHS - NUMBER, ALGEBRA, MEASUREMENT

- Solve problems using all four operations.
- Extend knowledge of factors and multiples to understand the properties of prime, composite and square numbers.
- Solve financial problems, choosing models, representations and calculation strategies and justify solutions.
- Use timetables of daily activities to solve practical problems.
- Find unknown values in numerical equations using combinations of arithmetic operations.

### » SCIENCE - PHYSICAL SCIENCES

Students will investigate and analyse the requirements for the transfer of electricity in a circuit and describe how energy can be transformed from one form to another to generate electricity. They will explore the role of circuit components, insulators and conductors.

### » HASS - HISTORY/ CIVICS AND CITIZENSHIP

Students will investigate and compare the rights and responsibilities of Australian citizens today and compare these with the experiences of different groups in the past. They will investigate the causes and effects of migration to Australia, learning about the motivations and stories of people migrating to Australia throughout the 20th century, and the impacts on Australian society. Students will locate, collect and organise information from primary and secondary sources and will evaluate sources.

### » MEDIA ARTS

Students explore how points of view, ideas and stories are shaped and portrayed in media artworks. They explain the purposes and audiences for media artworks made in different cultures, times and places. Students will create a documentary style film to tell the personal story of someone significant to them in the local or school community.

## Year 6 Expectations

**Homework:** We encourage students to be reading at home to ensure fluency and confidence. Mathematics is also accessible for independent practice. Teachers will communicate with parents around set homework tasks or research related to projects.

**Leadership:** throughout the term students will have the opportunity to volunteer for the following jobs: Reading reserves, recycling bins, prep readers, flags, and radio station.
