- Ask questions about the characters and story
- Encourage them to predict what might happen next
- Celebrate their imagination and ideas

Creating a Home Environment That Encourages Curiosity

Children are naturally curious. Having books easily available around the home helps children see reading as something enjoyable and accessible.

A small reading corner, a basket of favourite books, or regular visits to the library can help make books part of everyday life.
