

2024 Term 1 Curriculum in Prep

at Highland Reserve State School



English

Students will start the year with a focus on developing their oral language and phonemic awareness by learning to recognise rhyme, syllables and sounds in spoken words. They will listen to and experience a wide range of texts and will explore concepts about print and screen, including reading from left to right, front and back covers of books, titles and authors. Students will create and share items from their 'All About Me Box' to a familiar audience.

Maths

Students will count to and from 10 and will connect number names with matching numerals, objects and pictures. They will sort, name and describe familiar 2D shapes and identify 3D objects in their environment.

Science

Students will develop their understanding of science by observing and asking questions about everyday science topics, including the weather. They will participate in guided investigations and engage in discussions about their observations.
