English

Students read, view and listen to a range of texts to comprehend and compare the text structures and language features of informative texts. They will respond to literal and inferential questions. They will create an informative text with a supporting image.

Maths

Students will perform simple addition and subtraction problems using a range of strategies. Students will identify half and quarter turns, represent flips and slides and interpret simple maps. Students will use simple strategies to reason and solve location inquiry questions.

Science

Students will investigate life-stage and the changes that occur. They will experience firsthand an animal's lifecycle. Students will observe, compare, record and represent animal life stages, through hands-on scientific inquiry. They will demonstrate their understanding by designing and creating a 3D model.
