

2024 Term 2 Curriculum in Prep

English

Students listen to and engage with a range of literary and non-literary texts with a focus on exploring how language is used to entertain through retelling events. They will begin to sequence events from a range of texts and will continue to develop their oral language and identify rhyme and rhyming patterns in stories, poems and songs. They will begin to form letters when writing and write short statements and recounts based on familiar stories or events.

Maths

Students will continue to count to and from 10 and will connect number names with matching numerals, objects and pictures. Students answer simple questions to collect information and make simple inferences.

Science

Students will continue to develop their understanding of science by observing and asking questions about science topics including the properties of materials. They will participate in guided investigations and engage in discussions about their observations.

Design Technologies

Students will explore the purpose of familiar products and how they meet the needs of users. They will create and communicate ideas using simple drawings and follow sequenced steps and evaluate their designs.
